I am pleased to invite your Government to the Latin America and the Caribbean regional preparatory meeting for the sixth meeting of the Conference of the Parties to the Minamata Convention on Mercury (COP-6), scheduled to be held on 3-4 September 2025, in Santiago, Chile. The working languages of the meeting will be English and Spanish. Documents for the meeting, including practical information about the venue, will be made available to registered participants.

The provisional agenda for the meeting will be developed in cooperation with the COP-6 Bureau members and the GRULAC environment coordinator for the region and will be posted on the [COP-6 webpage](#) in due course. It is expected that the agenda will include presentations of the documents for COP-6 (to be held on 3-7 November 2025 in Geneva, Switzerland), followed by discussions among Governments and possible development of positions for the various issues to be addressed at COP-6.

In the nomination process of delegates to the meeting, Parties are strongly encouraged to ensure balanced gender representation within their delegations.

Participants are responsible for making their own arrangements to participate in the meeting, including visa and hotel arrangements.
