MERCURY MONITORING IN THE GLOBAL ENVIRONMENT: NEW INITIATIVES

In response to the need for understanding methylmercury exposure in the environment for ecohealth and human health purposes new initiatives are necessary for a standardized and holistic assessment at a global level. This event will highlight some of those new initiatives and demonstrate the ability of these initiatives to meet the needs being determined at the 4th Conference of Parties for evaluating the effectiveness of the Convention. Presentations will reflect on atmospheric mercury deposition networks being coordinated at a global level, projects approved by the Minamata Convention's Secretariat's Specific International Programme in the Caribbean (focal country is Antigua and Barbuda) and central Africa (focal country is Gabon), and grassroots efforts in Indonesia and Peru.
