COUNTRY PROGRESS AND WAY FORWARD IN PHASING DOWN THE USE OF DENTAL AMALGAM

WHO conducted a consultation with dental public health policymakers to understand the progress made in phasing-down the use of dental amalgam. The consultation showed that countries can accelerate their progress in reducing risks and better protecting our environment and human health. The side event aims to present progress and challenges in phasing down the use of dental amalgam; to share evidence-based information on management of dental caries with mercury-free products and minimal intervention; and to discuss multisectoral leadership and collaboration to support countries efforts with limited resources and a high prevalence of dental caries.
