SPECIFIC INTERNATIONAL PROGRAMME: ACHIEVEMENTS AND IMPACTS OF FIVE PROJECTS FROM AROUND THE WORLD

Article 13 of the Minamata Convention establishes a financial mechanism to support eligible parties to implement their obligations under the Convention. It includes the Specific International Programme (SIP) to support capacity-building and technical assistance which has to date, with the generous contributions of 10 donors, supported 24 projects around the world. The side event will include remarks from a Co-Chair of the SIP Governing Board and presentations from project managers of Armenia, Argentina, Lesotho, Iran and Moldova on the results and impacts achieved by their SIP projects.
